## **School News and Highlights**

Rheem First Graders Wow the School Board: Kudos to students in Mrs. Strohmeyer's class who joined the school board meeting to demonstrate a lesson in math reasoning and critical thinking. Their amazing math skills were on full display and nothing says learning more than demonstrating your work, and explaining your thinking.

#### In-Person Cohort A and B students

The key to keeping our in-person staff and students safe will be:

- 1. Staff and students stay home when they are sick
- 2. Wear a mask (two or more layers required)
- 3. Keep stable groups (at school, childcare, and home)
- 4. Stay physically distanced
- 5. Wash hands frequently

In order to make sure staff and students are safe we require all staff and students to complete a Daily Health Screener before arriving on campus. Students who do not have a completed Daily Health Screener will not be allowed in the classroom until the screener is complete. Please complete the daily screener by 9:00 each in-person day. <u>Directions</u>

#### Arrival and Dismissal

- TK-5th start of instruction = 12:15
- Please **DO NOT** arrive on campus before 12:05
- Students will be dropped off in the bus loop
- Students walking to school will enter via the Ascot Steps or Laird Drive

- Upon arrival, students will meet their teacher on the playground their first week of in-person learning
- After the first week, students will go directly to their classrooms (MAP)
- TK-5th dismissal = 3:00
- Parents must wear a mask
- Students will wait for cars physically distanced
- Students will leave campus after dismissal
- Parents who are walking home with their child should arrive at 3:00
- Parents will meet children at the Ascot Steps or the blue benches on Laird. Parents will not come on to campus during pick up.
- Parents will wear masks and stay at least 6 feet apart

Next week's schedule will be different due to the four day week:

- Tuesday = Cohort A in-person
- Wednesday = Distance Learning for all students
- Thursday = Cohort B in-person
- Friday = Cohort B in-person

The week of March 22nd will contain only one in-person day for Cohort B due to a minimum day.

## **Full Distance Learning Students**

Current (morning) teachers of full distance learning students will share your child's full distance learning afternoon schedule (FDL session 1 from 12:05-1:25 or session 2 from 1:40-3:00) along with the link to the FDL Teachers Zoom classroom. If you do not have that information please send Mrs. Fitzinger (Ifitzinger@moraga.k12.ca.us) or Mrs. Smith (esmith@moraga.k12.ca.us) an email and they will get you that information.

FDL afternoon sessions are balanced with students across the district. Students from the same class are in the same FDL session for social emotional reasons and to allow continuity of communication between teachers. We are not granting requests for specific session placement.

Next week's schedule will be different due to the four-day week:

- Tuesday = FDL afternoon sessions
- Wednesday = Distance Learning for all students (no FDL afternoon sessions)
- Thursday = FDL afternoon sessions
- Friday = FDL afternoon sessions
