Today <u>Contra Costa County's</u> seven-day average for cases per 100,000 dropped to an adjusted rate of 22.1 positive Covid cases per 100K. In order for schools to reopen, the county needs to remain at 25.0 or under for 5 consecutive days. It is looking very likely we will be opening for in person instruction K-5th grades on Tuesday, February 16th. I remember last year at this time watching the Super Bowl at a friend's house thinking the 49ers were on track to win their 6th Lombardi Trophy only to have the Chiefs take over in the 4th quarter and make for a less than enjoyable championship viewing. Little did I know that party would be the last normal get together I'd be a part of for the foreseeable future.

I know we are far from being out of the woods with this pandemic, but we are making strides to a return to normal with the pending reopening of schools. Rheem will look different for sure in the hybrid model, and we will need to learn new safety protocols in keeping everyone safe and healthy. To make this transition as seamless as possible, please be sure to help with the following:

- All students will be required to wear masks.
- Students will be reminded of mask wearing, hand washing, and physical distancing at the start of each day.

- Families must commit to symptom checks at home each day before entering campus. Students will not be able to enter classrooms if families have not submitted a daily screening via ParentSquare.
- Students will be dropped off each morning and walk independently to class. Parents will not be allowed to walk students to classrooms.
- Non-essential visitors will not be permitted on campus.
- All schools will use outdoor learning spaces when practicable.
- Learning will be set up with 4-6 feet distancing between students.
- Classrooms and school building furniture will be cleaned and disinfected
 according to California Department of Health guidelines
- Signage will be used to support physical distancing and proper hygiene practices.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be located throughout Rheem.

Thank you for your continued support, and no matter if your student is returning to in person learning or remaining in full DL we are all still in this together and our success relies on the whole Team doing our best.
